Subject: September 2022-Activity Report-Lowell Police Dept.

The Lowell Police Department responded to 542 total calls for service and served 69 outstanding warrants (Felony & Misdemeanor) in the month of September. Officers initiated 679 traffic stop investigations and issued 422 traffic citations along with 441 warnings. During the month, Lowell PD Officers made 85 criminal arrests and conducted 727 extra patrols (businesses & neighborhoods).

The 85 criminal arrests are based on arrests made on an active warrant from Lowell PD, other agencies, and officer's self-initiated patrol, such as traffic stop investigations. There were 148 incident reports taken in September.

The Lowell officers responded to 34 animal calls for service in September. There were 11 animals transported to the Lowell Animal Shelter and 7 animals were adopted. As of October 2nd, 2022, there are 29 animals housed inside the Lowell Animal Shelter.
