HOLIDAY SAFETY TIPS

With the holiday season upon us, and the weather turning colder, here are a few safety tips to help see us through.

Never connect more holiday light strings together than the manufacturer recommends, do not plug extension cords together and be sure you don't overload electrical circuits. Be sure to inspect all electrical cords and lighted display items for damage before using them. If you use extension cords inside, do not place them under rugs, furniture or other materials, and never use indoor cords or lights outside. This can cause the cord to overheat or short out.

If you have a "real" Christmas tree, make sure to give it plenty of water. The drier the tree, the more easily it will burn. So also test your smoke alarm monthly and replace the batteries every six months.

HOLIDAY SAFETY TIPS

The members of the Lowell Police Department would like to wish everyone a Happy Holiday Season. We would like to offer some safety tips to help keep you and your loved ones from becoming a victim of crime or preventable accidents.

### At Home

Don't display holiday gifts where they can be seen from doorways or windows. If you go out for the evening, leave the television and lights on so it will appear that someone is at home. If you plan on traveling, store gifts before you leave.

Be wary of strangers soliciting funds for charitable organizations. They may take advantage of people's generosity during the holidays. Ask for identification and how the donated funds will be used. If you don't get the appropriate answers don't contribute.

### While Shopping

Shop before dark if possible. Never park in an unlit area or parking lot. Lock your gifts in the trunk of the vehicle and keep the doors locked. Don't overburden yourself with packages and have your keys ready before you get to your vehicle. Look around and be aware of your surroundings and persons who are watching or following you.

### Holiday Party Safety

Have non-alcoholic beverages available for party guests. Serve food before serving the alcohol. High protein foods stay in the stomach longer and help slow the absorption into the bloodstream. Have alternative transportation available for persons who become intoxicated.
