

RESOLUTION NO. 00-05 - B

A RESOLUTION ADVANCING THE CITY OF  
LOWELL, ARKANSAS FROM A CITY OF THE  
SECOND CLASS TO A CITY OF THE FIRST CLASS.

WHEREAS, the special census filed with the Arkansas Secretary of State on September 25, 1996, established the population of Lowell, Arkansas at 2,846 inhabitants; and

WHEREAS, A.C.A. §14-37-108 allows a city of more than 2,500 inhabitants to advance from a city of the second class to a city of the first class upon application from the city and the adoption of a resolution by the City Council;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF LOWELL, ARKANSAS:

That the City of Lowell shall submit an application to the State Auditor, the Secretary of State and the Attorney General asking that the City of Lowell be declared a city of the first class as defined by Arkansas law, and that it shall operate in accordance with the laws applicable to cities of the first class.
